AN ACT to amend the Builders' Registration Act, 1939-1961.

[Assented to 21st October, 1965.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

Short title and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Builders' Registration Act Amendment Act, 1965.
