AN ACT to amend the Dog Act, 1903-1963.

[Assented to 1st October, 1965.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Dog Act Amendment Act, 1965*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Dog Act, 1903-1963, is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted in Vol. 18 of the Reprinted Acts.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Dog Act, 1903-1965. Approved for reprint, 4th June, 1964.

2. Section three of the principal Act is amended by adding immediately prior to the interpretation, "District", the following interpretation—

"Cattle" includes domesticated goat. .

3. Section twenty-two A of the principal Act is amended by deleting the passage, "not being an aboriginal or half-caste, except with the consent of the nearest Protector of Natives" in lines four, five and six.
