## AN ACT to amend the Foreign Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) Act, 1963.

[Assented to 25th November, 1965.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Foreign Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) Act Amendment Act, 1965.
- (2) In this Act the Foreign Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) Act, 1963, is referred to as the principal Act.

- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Foreign Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) Act, 1963-1965.
- 2. Subsection (2) of section four of the principal s.4 amended. Act is amended by adding after the figure, "1935", the passage, ", or under any Act repealed by that Act".
- 3. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section six <sup>S.6</sup> amended of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words, "Court of Sessions" in line three, the words, "Court of Session".
