B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Local Courts Act, 1904-1964.

2. Section sixteen of the principal Act is amended ^{S.16} amended. by substituting for the word, "Governor" in line two, the word, "Minister".

3. Section ninety-nine of the principal Act is $\frac{5.53}{\text{smended.}}$ amended by substituting for the words, "five hundred pounds" in line three, the words, "eight hundred pounds".

4. Section one hundred of the principal Act is $\frac{S.100}{amended}$. amended by substituting for the words, "five hundred pounds" in line two, the words, "eight hundred pounds".

5. Section one hundred and one of the principal ^{S. 101} Act is amended by substituting for the words, "five hundred pounds" in the last line the words, "eight hundred pounds".

6. Section one hundred and three of the principal ^{S. 103} amended. Act is amended by substituting for the words, "five hundred pounds" in line three and again in the second last line, the words, "eight hundred pounds".
