## CONSTITUTION ACTS AMENDMENT AND REVISION.

AN ACT to amend the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1962 for the purpose of reprinting, and for that purpose, where necessary, to revise certain of the Acts amending the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899.

[Assented to 3rd December, 1963.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution Acts Amendment and Revision Act, 1963.

1963.] Constitution Acts Amendment [No. 46. and Revision.

2. In this Act,—

"amending Acts" means the Acts No. 25 of 1933, No. 29 of 1942, No. 4 of 1947, No. 12 of 1948 and No. 45 of 1950;

"principal Act" means the Constitution Acts Amendment Act. 1899-1962.

3. The principal Act as amended by this Act  $\operatorname{Citation of}_{\operatorname{principal Act}}$  may be cited as the Constitution Acts Amendment  $\operatorname{as amended}_{\operatorname{by this Act.}}$ Act. 1899-1963.

4. Section five of the principal Act is amended  $\frac{5.5}{\text{amended.}}$  by substituting for the words, "hereinafter stated and defined", in line three, the words, "defined pursuant to section six of this Act".

Section six of the principal Act is repealed <sup>S.6</sup><sub>re-enacted</sub>. 5. and re-enacted with amendments, as follows:

(1) The State shall be divided into ten Electoral Provinces. 6. Electoral Provinces, under the provisions of the Electoral Districts Act, 1947, and shall return in all thirty members to serve in the Legislative Council.

(2) Each Electoral Province shall return three members.

Section eighteen of the principal Act is <sup>S.18</sup> amended. 6. amended by substituting for the words, "hereinafter stated and defined", in lines two and three, the words, "as defined pursuant to section nineteen of this Act".

7. Section nineteen of the principal Act is S. 19 re-enacted. repealed and re-enacted with amendments, as follows:

The State shall be divided into fifty Electoral Districts. 19 Electoral Districts, under the provisions of the Electoral Districts Act, 1947, each returning one member to serve in the Legislative Assembly.

10. (1) The amending Acts are amended to the extent specified in column four of the Schedule to this Act.

(2) Subsection (1) of this section shall not be construed as affecting the provisions of the Amendments Incorporation Act, 1938.
