AN ACT to amend sections six hundred and seventy and six hundred and eighty, and repeal section seven hundred and thirty-five of the Criminal Code.

[Assented to 17th December, 1963.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Criminal Code Amendment Act (No. 2), 1963.*

(2) In this Act—

“the Code” means the Criminal Code set forth in the Schedule to the Criminal Code Act, 1913, set forth in Appendix B to the Criminal Code Act Compilation Act, 1913,

3. Section six hundred and seventy of the Code is amended by deleting the passage, "or being any aboriginal native," in line two.

4. Section six hundred and eighty of the Code is amended—

(a) by deleting the passage, "and except in the case of an aboriginal native," in line six; and

(b) by deleting the paragraph commencing with the words, "The punishment", in line fourteen down to and including the passage, "sergeant." in line seventeen.
