AN ACT to amend section four of the Firearms and Guns Act, 1931-1963.

[Assented to 18th December, 1963.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Firearms and Guns Act Amendment Act (No. 2)*, 1963.

(2) In this Act the Firearms and Guns Act, 1931-1963, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Firearms and Guns Act, 1931-1963.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day ^{Commence-}

3. Section four of the principal Act is amended ^{S. 4}
by deleting the passage, "and to every person who ^{amended.}
is a native within the meaning of the Native
Administration Act, 1905-1936" in lines four, five,
six and seven of paragraph (2).
