BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Adoption of Children Act, 1896-1959, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Adoption of Children Act, 1896-1962.

2. Section seven of the principal Act is $\frac{S.7}{amended}$. amended—

- (a) by adding, after the word, "child" in line one of the proviso, the words, "or the issue of that child"; and
- (b) by adding, after the word, "child" in line three of paragraph (1) of the proviso, the words, "or remoter issue".
