## AN ACT to amend the Firearms and Guns Act. 1931-1960.

[Assented to 27th September, 1962.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Firearms short title and Guns Act Amendment Act, 1962.

- (2) In this Act the Firearms and Guns Act, 1931- young 1960, is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act further may be cited as the Firearms and Guns Act, Acts Nos. 70 of 1956 and 1931-1962.

- Section twelve of the principal Act is amended by adding after item 13 in the table to the section, the following description of offence in the first column of the table and the following penalty opposite thereto in the second column of the table:—
  - 13A. Without lawful excuse, knowingly discharging any shot, bullet or other missile from a firearm onto, from or across any road
