- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Licensing* Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1962.
- (2) In this Act the Licensing Act, 1911-1961, is referred to as the principal Act.
- 2. Section one hundred and twenty-two of the crincipal Act is amended by substituting for the

words, "outside an area bounded by a circle having a radius of twenty miles from the Town Hall in Perth" in lines three, four, five and six of subparagraph (i) of paragraph (c) of subsection (2), the words, "at least twenty miles distant from the Town Hall in Perth when measured by the shortest road route."
