**AN ACT to amend the Stamp Act, 1921-1960.**

[Assented to 30th October, 1961.]

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Stamp Act Amendment Act, 1961*.

(2) In this Act the Stamp Act, 1921-1960, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Stamp Act, 1921-1961.

2. Section sixteen of the principal Act is <sup>S. 16</sup> amended—

(a) by substituting for the word, "From", being the first word in the section, the following passage—

(1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, from ; and

(b) by adding a subsection as follows—

(2) Without prejudice to the operation of section nineteen of this Act, no stamp duties shall be charged as provided in subsection (1) of this section upon any instrument that contains or relates to a transaction in the official short term money market.
