AN ACT to amend the Architects Act, 1921-1956.

[Assented to 21st October, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Architects Act Amendment Act, 1960.*

(2) In this Act the Architects Act, 1921-1956, is referred to as the principal Act.

2. Section fourteen of the principal Act is amended by deleting the passage, "resides in Western Australia," in line six.

3. Subsection (4) of section fifteen of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word, "two" where it occurs in lines two and three, the word, "four."
