AN ACT to authorise Local Authorities to Expend Amounts Exceeding Three per Centum of their Ordinary Revenue for purposes connected with the preliminary arrangements for and the holding of The VII British Empire and Commonwealth Games in Perth in this State in the year one thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.

RE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:----

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Authorities, Short title and eltation. British Empire and Commonwealth Games Contributions Authorisation Act, 1960.

Authorisation of expenditure of ordinary revenue. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions

of section three hundred and thirty-five of the Road Districts Act, 1919, or of section four hundred and eighty of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906, which provisions limit expenditure for certain purposes to a sum not exceeding three per centum of the ordinary revenue mentioned in those sections,

councils of municipalities and boards of road districts are authorised with the approval of the Minister to expend from their ordinary revenue, such sums as they think fit for purposes connected with the preliminary arrangements for and the holding of The VII British Empire and Commonwealth Games in Perth in this State in the year one thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.
