AN ACT to Impose a Tax on Money Paid in respect of Bets made through or with the Totalisator Agency Board established under the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960.

[Assented to 28th November, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Totalisator short title. Agency Board Betting Tax Act, 1960.
- 2. The rate of Totalisator Agency Board betting Totalisator tax imposed by this Act and payable under the betting tax. Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960, is five

pounds per centum of all moneys paid to the Totalisator Agency Board in respect of bets made through or with that Board, under the provisions of that Act.
