AN ACT to amend the Albany Harbour Board Act. 1926-1955.

[Assented to 20th November, 1959.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Albany Harbour Board Act Amendment Act, 1959.
- (2) In this Act the Albany Harbour Board Act, 1926-1955, is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Albany Harbour Board Act, 1926-1959.

2. (1) Section fifty-five of the principal Act is $\frac{5.55}{\text{repealed and}}$ repealed and re-enacted with amendments as $\frac{\text{re-enacted.}}{\text{re-enacted.}}$ follows—

55. All drafts upon the Treasury or cheques drawn for expenditure by the Board shall be signed by one member and countersigned by the Secretary to the Board.
