AN ACT to amend the Bunbury Harbour Board Act, 1909-1957.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:----

Short title and citation. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Bunbury Harbour Board Act Amendment Act, 1959.

> (2) In this Act the Bunbury Harbour Board Act, 1909-1957, is referred to as the principal Act.

> (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Bunbury Harbour Board Act, 1909-1959.

55. All drafts upon the Treasury or cheques signatures on drafts drawn for expenditure by the Board shall be and cheques. signed by one member and countersigned by the Secretary to the Board.
