AN ACT to amend the Factories and Shops Act, 1920-1957.

[Assented to 10th December, 1959.]

RE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

(1) This Act may be cited as the Factories short title 1. and Shops Act Amendment Act, 1959.

(2) In this Act the Factories and Shops Act, Reprinted in Yol. 10 of The 1920-1957, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act 19th June, may be cited as the Factories and Shops Act, 1920-1959.

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
