No. 7 of 1959.

AN ACT to amend the Justices Act, 1902-1957 and to repeal section sixty-nine A of the Traffic Act, 1919-1958.

[Assented to 7th September, 1959.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Justices Act Amendment Act*, 1959.

Reprinted as approved 1st December, 1958.

- (2) In this Act the Justices Act, 1902-1957, is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Justices Act, 1902-1959.

Section one hundred and fifty-seven of the s. 157 amended. principal Act is amended by adding after the word. "charges" in line nineteen, the words, "including and execution of the warrant the issue commitment and".

Section one hundred and fifty-eight of the s. 158 amended. principal Act is amended by adding after the word, "charges" in line twelve, the words, "including the issue and execution of the warrant and".

Subsection (1) of section one hundred and s. 167 amended. sixty-seven of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words, "three days" in line seven, the words "one day".

The Act mentioned in the Schedule to this Act Traffic Act, 1919-1958 is amended in accordance with the Schedule and amended. as so amended may be cited as prescribed in that Schedule.
