AN ACT to impose a Metropolitan Region Improvement Tax.

[Assented to 10th December, 1959.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Metropolitan Region Improvement Tax Act, 1959.

2. For the year of assessment ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty, and for each year of assessment thereafter up to the year of assessment ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred

and sixty-two, the rate of Metropolitan Region Improvement Tax imposed by this Act and payable under the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act, 1959, is one halfpenny for every pound of the unimproved value as assessed by or under that Act and the Land Tax Assessment Act, 1907, of all land chargeable with the tax.
