

**MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS
(POSTPONEMENT OF 1958
ELECTIONS).**

AN ACT for the purpose of postponing in the year one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight elections under the *Municipal Corporations Act, 1906*, and for other and incidental purposes.

[*Assented to 11th November, 1958.*]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Municipal Corporations (Postponement of 1958 Elections) Act, 1958*.

2. In order to avoid inconvenience which, but for the enactment of this section, might arise because the fourth Saturday in November, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight, has been appointed for the holding of Commonwealth Parliamentary elections, it is hereby enacted that for the purposes of holding elections under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906 in the year one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight

Postponement of elections.

- (a) the reference in section seventy-seven of that Act to the fourth Saturday in November shall be deemed to be a reference to Saturday, the twenty-ninth day of November in the year one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight; and
- (b) the nomination day referred to in section ninety-two of that Act shall be deemed to be the fifteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight.
