## AN ACT to amend the Bookmakers Betting Tax Act. 1954.

[Assented to 18th December, 1956.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

## Short title and citation.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Bookmakers* Betting Tax Act Amendment Act, 1956.
- (2) In this Act the Bookmakers Betting Tax Act, 1954.

Act No. 62 of 1954, is referred to as the principal Act.

- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Bookmakers Betting Tax Act. 1954-1956
- Section two of the principal Act is amended S. 2 am. by substituting for the passage commencing with the word, "is" in line three and ending with the word, "bookmaker" being the last word in the section, the following paragraphs-
  - (a) is, in respect of turnover mentioned in 114% on all turnover to paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section proclaimed day. fourteen of the Betting Control Act, 1954, the rate of one and one-quarter per centum:

(b) is, in respect of turnover mentioned in 134% on first paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section on-course turnover in fourteen of the Betting Control Act, 1954, each year after protein rate of one and one-quarter per claimed day. centum;

(c) is, in respect of turnover mentioned in 11/2% on on-course paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section exceeding fourteen of the Betting Control Act, 1954, 550,000 in the rate of one and one-half per centum; after proclaimed day.

and

(d) is, in respect of turnover mentioned in 2% on all off-course paragraph (e) of subsection (2) of section turnover in each year fourteen of the Betting Control Act, 1954, after prothe rate of two per centum.
