AN ACT to amend the Cemeteries Act, 1897-1955.

BE it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Cemeteries Act Amendment Act, 1956.

- (2) In this Act the Cemeteries Act, 1897-1946, Act 61 Victoriae No. 23, 1897, as amended by Acts 62 Victoriae No. 25, 1898, 63 Victoriae No. 38, 1899, 2 Edwardi VII., No. 42, 1902, No. 22 of 1911, No. 28 of 1946 and No. 14 of 1955,
