AN ACT to amend the Health Act, 1911-1955.

[Assented to 26th October, 1956.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Health Act Short title and citation. Amendment Act, 1956.
 - (2) In this Act the Health Act, 1911-1955,

- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Health Act, 1911-1956.

- 2. Section three hundred and twenty-four of the principal Act is repealed and re-enacted amended as follows:—
 - 324. (1) Every local authority may subsidise any district nursing system, infant health centre or hospital, public or private, for the reception of the sick generally.
 - (2) Every local authority—
 - (a) may provide, establish and maintain;and
 - (b) may grant financial aid towards the establishment and maintenance of:

any scheme or any institution or centre, whether residential or otherwise, for the care of the aged.
