## AN ACT to amend the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1954.

[Assented to 4th January, 1957.]

BE it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Municipal Corporations Act Amendment Act, 1956.

(2) In this Act the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1954.

The council may undertake the control acclimatisa-250A. and management of any acclimatisation district in respect of which it is registered as a trout acclimatisation society under the provisions of Part IIIA. of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1956, and, subject to that Act, may do all such acts and things as may be deemed necessary or expedient in or about the hatching, rearing, distribution or protection of trout and the control and management of the acclimatisation district.
