AN ACT relating to Reserve A¹¹⁶² (Perth town lot 55, Parliament House site).

[Assented to 27th December, 1956.]

BE it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. Cf. Acts 1. This Act may be cited as the Parliament House Site Permanent Reserve $(A^{\uparrow}1162)$ Act, 1956.

2. In this Act—

"departmental buildings" means the buildings which, when this Act comes into operation, are erected and used for the purposes of 1956.] Parliament House Site [No. 59. Permanent Reserve (A^1162).

"land" means the land comprising Reserve A^1162 dedicated to the purpose of Parliamentary Buildings.

3. That portion of the land—

occupied by and used in connection with depart- ^{58. 29 and 31.} mental buildings already erected when this Act comes into operation;

necessary for occupation by departmental buildings;

may,

for a term of three years commencing on the twenty-first day of November, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six,

continue so to be occupied and used in all respects as if to that extent that portion were reserved for the use and requirements of the Government pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (b) of section twenty-nine of the Land Act, 1933, notwithstanding that the land is dedicated to the use of Parliamentary Buildings.
