AN ACT to amend the Trade Descriptions and False Advertisements Act, 1936-1953.

[Assented to 27th December, 1956.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

Short title and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Trade Descriptions and False Advertisements Act Amendment Act, 1956.
