AN ACT to amend the Trustees Act, 1900-1955.

BE it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Trustees Act short title Amendment Act, 1956.

(2) In this Act, the Trustees Act, 1900-1955,

 - (a) by redesignating as paragraph (k), the paragraph added as paragraph (j) by section two of Act No. 54 of 1955; and
 - (b) by adding the following paragraphs—
 - (I) on deposit in the Savings Bank Division of the Rural and Industries Bank of Western Australia;
 - (m) on deposit in any savings bank authorised to carry on savings bank business under the Banking Act, 1945 of the Commonwealth Parliament or under any Act passed in amendment of or substitution for that Act.
