## BOOKMAKERS BETTING TAX.

AN ACT to Impose a Tax on Money Paid or Promised as the Consideration for Bets made by or on behalf of Bookmakers.

[Assented to 30th December, 1954.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Bookmakers Betting Tax Act, 1954.

Bookmakers betting tax. Cf. Betting Control Act, 1954, s. 12. 2. The rate of bookmakers betting tax imposed by this Act and payable under the Betting Control Act, 1954, is one and one-quarter per centum of amounts of money paid or promised as the consideration for bets made by a bookmaker or his agent on his behalf, in the capacity of bookmaker.
