AN ACT to amend The Shipping and Pilotage Consolidation Ordinance, 1855 and Act 37 Victoriae No. 14 entitled An Act to Alter and Extend the Provisions of the Shipping and Pilotage Consolidation Ordinance, 1855.

[Assented to 22nd September, 1954.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Shipping and Short title. Pilotage Ordinance Amendment Act, 1954.
- 2. (1) In this section, The Shipping and Pilotage be read with Consolidation Ordinance, 1855 (Ordinance 18 principal Act as Victoriæ No. 15 as amended by Acts 37 Victoriæ amended. No. 14, 47 Victoriæ No. 17, 1 and 2 Edwardi VII. No. 14, No. 58 of 1919 and No. 15 of 1926 and as affected by Act No. 8 of 1917), is referred to as the principal Act.

Amendment of Acta: The Schedule. (2) Such of those Acts as are mentioned in the first column of the Schedule to this Act are amended to the extent shown in the second column of that Schedule.

Citation of Principal Act as amended. (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Shipping and Pilotage Act, 1855-1954.

First Column.

The Shipping and Pilotage Consolidation Ordinance, 1855 (Ordinance 18 Victoriæ No. 15).

Act 37 Victoriæ No. 14 entitled An Act to Alter and Extend the provisions of 'The Shipping and Pilotage Consolidation Ordinance, 1855.'

Second Column.

Substitute for the word "TONNAGE" in scale D of the Schedule the word "CONSERVANCY".

Substitute for the word "tonnage" in sections one and two the word "conservancy".
