 $B^{\rm E}$ it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:----

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Trade short title Descriptions and False Advertisements Act Amendment Act [No. 2], 1953.

(2) In this Act the Trade Descriptions and False Advertisements Act, 1936-1944.

Act No. 42 of 1936 as amended by Act No. 46 of 1944,

is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Trade Descriptions and False Advertisements Act, 1936-1953.

2. Section eight of the principal Act is amended ^{S.8} by-

(a) adding after the word, "radio" in paragraph (e) of subsection (2) the word, "or";
