AN ACT to amend the Nurses Registration Act, 1921-1948.

[Assented to 19th December, 1951.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

- This Act may be cited as the Nurses Registration Act Amendment Act, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Nurses Registration Act, 1921-1948 (Act No. 7 of 1922, as reprinted pursuant to the Amendments Incorporation Act, 1938, with amendments to and including Act No. 32 of 1939, incorporated in Volume 2 of the Reprinted Acts of the Parliament of Western Australia, 1943, and further amended by Acts Nos. 14 of 1944, 14 of 1946, and 36 of 1948), referred to in this Act as the principal Act.
- This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation.

Citation of principal Act as amended by this Act.

3. The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Nurses Registration Act, 1921-1951.

S. 5 amended.

- 4. Subsection (5b) of section five of the principal Act is amended by—
 - (a) substituting for the words, "eighteen months" in lines four and five, the words, "two years";
 - (b) substituting for the word, "nine" in line sixteen, the word, "twelve".
