AN ACT to amend the Pig Industry Compensation Act, 1942-1949.

[Assented to 20th November, 1951.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Pig Industry* Short title. Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Pig Industry Compensation Act, 1942-1949 (Act No. 38 of 1942, as amended by Act No. 44 of 1949), referred to in this Act as the principal Act.

- 2. The principal Act, as amended by this Act, Citation of may be cited as the Pig Industry Compensation Act, as amended by this Act. 1942-1951.
- 3. The principal Act is amended by adding after Amendment the words, "swine fever" wherever they occur in 7(2), 3(2) paragraph (c) of section six, subsection (2) of (2) and (3). section seven, subsections (2) and (3) of section eight and subsections (2) and (3) of section nine the words, ", swine erysipelas or para-typhoid".
- 4. The principal Act is amended by substituting Ss. 5 and 9 for the words, "Under Secretary for Agriculture" wherever they occur in sections five and nine, the words, "Director of Agriculture".
- 5. The proviso to subsection (2) of section seven \$\frac{\text{Proviso to}}{\text{s.7}\ (2)}\$ of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words, "ten pounds" in line three, the words, "fifteen pounds".
 - 6. Section ten of the principal Act is repealed. Solution Section ten of the principal Act is repealed.
- 7. The proviso to subsection (2) of section fifteen Froviso to of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words, "two shillings and sixpence" in lines five and six, the words, "three shillings and ninepence".
