AN ACT to Amend the Bulk Handling Act, 1935-1948.

[Assented to 17th November, 1950.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Bulk Handling Act Amendment Act*, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Bulk Handling Act, 1935-1948 (Act No. 40 of 1935, reprinted with the Second Schedule as amended by Orders in Council dated the thirtieth day of January, 1936, and the thirteenth day of November, 1936, in the Appendix to the Sessional Volume of Acts, 1936, and further amended by Acts Nos. 22 of 1943, 2 of 1946 and 80 of 1948, and as to the Second Schedule by Orders in Council dated the eighth day of December, 1937, the twenty-fourth day of November and the twenty-first day of December, 1938, the sixteenth day of August and the twenty-ninth day of September, 1939, the twenty-sixth day of February, 1941, and the sixth day of March, 1942), hereinafter called the principal Act.

Citation of principal Act as amended by this Act. 2. The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Bulk Handling Act, 1935-1950.

Commencement. 3. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.

4. Section twenty-six A of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "subsection" in line nine of the proviso to subsection (2) the words "and the tolls including any arrears of tolls shall be a first charge in priority to all other claims on the moneys payable under the Commonwealth Act or Acts in respect of the relative wheat."
