**AN ACT to amend the Superannuation, Sick, Death,
Insurance, Guarantee and Endowment (Local
Governing Bodies' Employees) Funds Act, 1947-
1949.**

[Assented to 17th November, 1950.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same. as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Superannuation, Sick, Death, Insurance, Guarantee and Endowment (Local Governing Bodies' Employees) Funds Act Amendment Act, 1950*, and shall be read as one with the Superannuation, Sick, Death, Insurance, Guarantee and Endowment (Local Governing

Bodies' Employees) Funds Act, 1947-1949 (Act No. 58 of 1947 as amended by Act No. 12 of 1949), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Superannuation, Sick, Death, Insurance, Guarantee and Endowment (Local Governing Bodies' Employees) Funds Act, 1947-1950.

Citation of principal Act as amended by this Act.

3. Section two of the principal Act is amended by adding after the words, "and a Board of Parks and Reserves appointed under the Parks and Reserves Act, 1895-1947," the words, "and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions of this interpretation, such other persons as those whom the Governor, by proclamation, may declare to be corporations for the purposes of the provisions of this Act".

Amendment of s. 2.

4. The principal Act is amended by adding after section four, the following section:—

s. 4A added.

4A. The Governor, by proclamation, may declare any persons to be corporations for the purposes of the provisions of this Act, and may, by the same or any other proclamation, declare any scheme referred to in section three of this Act, in operation when the proclamation is made and any agreement entered into before the proclamation is made for carrying into operation or for facilitating the operation of the scheme, to be valid and ratified on and from the day on which it was put into operation or executed as the case may be, and thereupon the scheme and all agreements executed and things done in putting the scheme into operation and maintaining it in operation, shall be validated and ratified.

Provision for proclamations extending operation of this Act to additional corporations and validating schemes.
