No. 38 of 1947.**AN ACT relating to the Royal Style and Titles of His Majesty.**

[Assented to 11th December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Royal Style and Titles Act, 1947*, and shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

2. Every Act and every schedule, form, regulation, rule, rule of court and by-law enacted, prescribed or made in, pursuant to, or under the authority of any Act in which appears as part of the Royal Style and Titles of His Majesty the words "Indiæ Emperor," or "Emperor of India," shall be deemed and is hereby amended by the omission therefrom of such words wherever they appear as part of the Royal Style and Titles.
