AN ACT to amend section forty-two of the Native Administration Act, 1905-1941.

[Assented to 11th December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Native Administration Act Amendment Act, 1947*, and shall be read as one with the Native Administration Act, 1905-1941 (No. 14 of 1905 as reprinted in the Appendix to the Sessional Volume of the Statutes for the year 1936, and amended by the Acts No. 37 of 1940 and No. 4 of 1941), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

(2) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Native Administration Act, 1905-1947.

Citation.

2. Section forty-two of the principal Act is amended as follows:—

Amendment
of s. 42.

(a) By deleting the words "municipal district or town or any other place" in line three, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "place or area specified or defined in the proclamation."

(b) By adding thereto a subsection as follows:—

(2) The Governor may, by any subsequent proclamation, revoke or vary any proclamation under this section.
