

LOTTERIES (CONTROL) (CONTINUANCE.)

AN ACT to continue the operation of the Lotteries
(Control) Act, 1932-1946.

[Assented to 10th October, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western
Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by
the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Lotteries (Control) Act Amendment (Continuance) Act, 1947*, and shall be read as one with the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932-1946 (No. 50 of 1932, as amended by the Acts Nos. 39 of 1933, 33 of 1934, 24 of 1935, 35 of 1936, 53 of 1937, 46 of 1938, 18 of 1939, 31 of 1940, 30 of 1941, 27 of 1942, 15 of 1943, 38 of 1944, and 44 of 1946), hereinafter called the principal Act. Short title.

2. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932-1947. Citation of principal Act as amended.

3. Section twenty-one of the principal Act is amended by deleting the word "forty-seven" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty." Amendment of s. 21 of the principal Act.
