AN ACT to continue the operation of the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932-1946.

[Assented to 10th October, 1947.]

RE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Lotteries (Control) short title. Act Amendment (Continuance) Act, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932-1946 (No. 50 of 1932, as amended by the Acts Nos. 39 of 1933, 33 of 1934, 24 of 1935, 35 of 1936, 53 of 1937, 46 of 1938, 18 of 1939, 31 of 1940, 30 of 1941, 27 of 1942, 15 of 1943. 38 of 1944, and 44 of 1946), hereinafter called the principal Act.

- 3. Section twenty-one of the principal Act is amended by deleting the word "forty-seven" and inserting in lieu principal Act. thereof the word "fifty."
