AN ACT to continue the operation of the Economic Stability Act, 1946.

[Assented to 7th November, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Economic Stability Act Amendment (Continuance) Act, 1947*, and shall be read as one with the Economic Stability Act, 1946 (62 of 1946), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section twelve of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word "October" in line two the word "December," and for the word "forty-seven" in line three the word "forty-eight." Amendment of s. 12.

3. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Economic Stability Act, 1946-1947. Citation of principal Act as amended.
