No. 2 of 1947.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-seven of the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899 (63 Vict. 19).

[Assented to 26th September, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Constitution Acts Amendment Act (No. 1), 1947*, and shall be read as one with the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899 (63 Vict., 19), as amended by Act No. 25 of 1927, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. Section thirty-seven of the principal Act is amended by deleting the word "six" in the first line of the proviso and substituting the word "eight."

3. This Act shall be deemed to have had effect on and from the day on which Act No. 25 of 1927 was proclaimed to come into operation, namely, the fourteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.
