AN ACT to continue the operation of the Commonwealth Powers Act, 1945-1947.

[Assented to 13th January, 1948.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Commonwealth Powers Act, 1945-1947, Amendment (Continuance) Act, 1947*, and shall be read as one with the Commonwealth Powers Act, 1945-1947 (No. 57 of 1945, as amended by No. 31 of 1947.) Short title.

2. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Commonwealth Powers Act, 1945-1947. Citation of principal Act as amended by this Act.

3. Section six of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word "forty-seven" in line five the word "forty-eight." Amendment of s. 6.
