AN ACT to amend the **Electoral (War Time) Act, 1943**,
and to continue its operation.

[Assented to 23rd October, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western
Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by
the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Electoral (War Time) Act Amendment Act, 1946*, and shall be read as one with the Electoral (War Time) Act, 1943 (Act No. 28 of 1943 as amended by Act No. 30 of 1945), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section five of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the words "but within" in the fourth line, the words "Japan, Borneo or."

3. Section nine of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "commissioned" in the first line of paragraph (a) the words "or non-commissioned."

4. Section eleven of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "commissioned" in the first line of subsection (2) the words "or non-commissioned."

of s. 16.

5. Section sixteen of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "commissioned" in the first line of paragraph (b) of the proviso, the words "or non-commissioned."

Repeal of
sections 17,
18, 20, 23, 24
and 25.

6. Sections seventeen, eighteen, twenty, twenty-three, twenty-four and twenty-five of the principal Act are repealed.

7. Section thirty-two of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "or person employed under the authority or direction of the Allied Works Council" in lines two, three and four thereof and by deleting the words "or employment under the authority or direction of the Allied Works Council" in the sixth and seventh lines thereof.

8. Section thirty-four of the principal Act is amended by deleting the word "forty-six" in the third line and substituting the word "forty-seven."
