AN ACT to amend subsection (3) of section six of the Public Service Appeal Board Act, 1920-1943.

[Assented to 30th January, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title of No. 10 of 1943, s. 4. 1. This Act may be cited as the Public Service Appeal Board Act Amendment Act, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Public Service Appeal Board Act, 1920-1943 (No. 14 of 1920 as reprinted in the Appendix to the Sessional Volume of Statutes for the year 1930 and amended by the Acts No. 19 of 1932, No. 29 of 1935, No. 27 of 1937, No. 21 of 1941 and No. 10 of 1943), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Amendment of ss. (3) of s. 6.

2. Subsection (3) of section six of the principal Act is amended by adding to such subsection (3) a further proviso as follows:—

Provided further that in the computation of such period of five years as is mentioned in the first paragraph of this subsection any period of employment during such time as is mentioned in the first proviso to this subsection shall be excluded.

Citation of principal Act as amended.

3. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Public Service Appeal Board Act, 1920-1945.
