AN ACT to amend the Mines Regulation Act, 1906-1938.

[Assented to 18th October, 1945.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Mines Regulation Act Amendment Act, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Mines Regulation Act, 1906-1938 (Act No. 36 of 1906 as reprinted in Volume 1 of the Reprinted Acts of the Parliament of Western Australia), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Section sixty-five of the principal Act is amended of s. 65 of the principal Act.
