AN ACT to amend section 5 of the Builders' Registration Act, 1939-1940.

[Assented to 8th December, 1944.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

This Act may be cited as the Builders' Registration Short title. Act Amendment Act, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Builders' Registration Act, 1939-1940 (No. 29 of 1939) as reprinted in Volume 2 of the Reprinted Acts of the Parliament of Western Australia), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. Section five of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by deleting the word "four" from the first line of paragraph (c) and inserting the word "five" in lieu thereof.

(b) by deleting the words "the President of the Royal Institute of the Architects" from line two of paragraph (c) and inserting "the President of the West Australian Chapter of the Royal Australian Institute of Architects" in lien thereof.

(c) by adding after the word "Australia" in line five of paragraph (c) the following "a representative of the workers engaged in the building trade nominated by the Governor."

Citation of principal Act as amended. 3. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Builders' Registration Act, 1939-1944.
