AN ACT to continue the operation of the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932-1941.

[Assented to 23rd December, 1942.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Lotteries (Control) Act Amendment Act, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932 (No. 50 of 1932 as amended by the Acts No. 39 of 1933, No. 33 of 1934, No. 24 of 1935, No. 35 of 1936, No. 53 of 1937, No. 46 of 1938, No. 18 of 1939, No. 31 of 1940 and No. 30 of 1941), hereinafter called the principal Act.

Amendment of s. 21, continuance of Act. 2. Section twenty-one of the principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the words "forty-two" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "forty-three."

Citation of principal Act as amended.

3. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932-1942.
