AN ACT to terminate the obligations imposed upon the Treasurer of the State by paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section eight of the Tramways Purchase Act, 1912.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by

This Act may be cited as the Tramways Purchase short sitle. 1. Act Amendment Act, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Tramways Purchase Act, 1912 (No. 31 of 1912), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. As from and including the first day of January, Obligations one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, but subject as surer under hereinafter provided, the obligations imposed upon the (a) of sub-Treasurer of the State by paragraph (a) of subsection of section (1) (1) of section eight of the principal Act shall be and are of the prin-cipal Act hereby terminated and the said paragraph (a) shall no longer operate or have effect:
