## No. 24 of 1939.

AN ACT to amend section ninety-eight of the as reprinted Administration Act, 1903-1934, pursuant to the provisions of section seventyseven of the Administration Act (Estate and Succession Duties) Amendment Act. 1934.

[Assented to 22nd November, 1939.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

This Act may be cited as the Administration Act Short title. Amendment Act, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Administration Act, 1903-1934 (No. 13 of 1903 as amended by the Acts No. 29 of 1909, No. 9 of 1918. No. 13 of 1921, No. 29 of 1922, and No. 28 of 1934, and as cf. No. 28 of 1934, and as cf. No. 28 of 1934. reprinted pursuant to section seventy-seven of the Act No. 28 of 1934), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. Section ninety-eight of the principal Act, being Amendment section thirty-nine in the Act No. 28 of 1934, is amended principal Act. by adding thereto a proviso as follows:-

Provided that this section shall not apply if and when the final balance of the estate of the deceased person, or the aggregate value of the property disposed of under settlement or settlements, or the value of the property disposed of under the nontestamentary disposition (as the case may be) in relation to which the beneficial interests aforesaid pass to such persons exceeds the sum of six thousand pounds.

Provided also that notwithstanding the next preceding proviso this section shall apply if and when the person from whom the property passes, whether under a will or a settlement or settlements or a nontestamentary disposition, is at the time of his death a member of the military, air, or naval forces of His Majesty the King, engaged on active service in connection with any war being waged between the Commonwealth of Australia and any other power, and his death is the direct result of such person being engaged on such active service aforesaid.
