### AN ACT to amend section ninety-eight of the Licensing Act, 1911-1934.

[Assented to 16th December, 1939.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1939*, and shall be read as one with the Licensing Act, 1911 (No. 32 of 1911), as reprinted in the Appendix to the Sessional Volume of Statutes for the year 1928 and amended by the Acts No. 27 of 1928, No. 41 of 1928, No. 23 of 1929, No. 30 of 1930, No. 27 of 1931, No. 36 of 1931, No. 49 of 1931, and No. 35 of 1934, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short title.

2. Section ninety-eight of the principal Act (as amended by section two of the Act No. 41 of 1928 and by section two of the Act No. 35 of 1934) is hereby amended by deleting the word "forty" in line one and inserting in lieu thereof the words "forty-five."
