AN ACT to amend section five of the Nurses Registration Act, 1921-1937.

[Assented to 16th December, 1939.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Act Amendment Act*, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Nurses Registration Act, 1921-1937 (No. 7 of 1922 as amended by the Acts No. 25 of 1922 and No. 14 of 1937), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section five of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "certified as having had not less than three years'" in lines two and three of subsection (3) and inserting in lieu thereof the words "certified as having completed the prescribed course of"; and by inserting after the word "training" in line three of the same subsection the words "as prescribed by the Board." Amendment of s. 5 of the principal Act.
